Financial Director's Comments:

- Paid all 2019 property taxes of about \$6,000 in October 2020 including small \$161 penalty.
- Owe Yearend CPA Financial Compilation for 2019 still that I never ordered. Was still an outstanding bill of \$275 for CPA last year. As Financial Director, I am not going to order a 2020 Financial Compilation just 2020 Tax Return which will significantly lower our costs.
- Paid part of 2019 City Treasurer city liquor license for \$142.50 that just showed up out the blue. This costs \$250 annually due 11/1 that city requires online only.
- All known bills have been paid except all of CPA bill noted above. There are several for city business license \$700 and \$250 city liquor license. Also, state liquor license coming up of \$350. Then, there is 2020 tax bill with one half in December that may be deferred.
- As of 10/26/2020, we have \$4,744 in checking and \$11,095 in savings.
- Thanks again for your memberships and donations.
